#### The Ten Commandments

- 1 And God spoke all these words:
- **2** "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.
- **3** "You shall have no other gods before me.
- **4** "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.
- **5** You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me,
- **6** but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.
- **7** "You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.
- **8** "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
- **9** Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

- **10** but the seventh day is a sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns.

- **12** "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.
- 13 "You shall not murder.

- 15 "You shall not steal.
- **16** "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
- **17** "You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."
- **18** When the people saw the thunder and lightning and heard the trumpet and saw the mountain in smoke, they trembled with fear. They stayed at a distance **19** and said to Moses, "Speak to us yourself and we
- will listen. But do not have God speak to us or we will die."
- **20** Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. God has come to test you, so that the fear of God will be with you to keep you from sinning."

## The Parable of the Wedding Banquet

- **5** "But they paid no attention and went off—one to his field, another to his business.
- **6** The rest seized his servants, mistreated them and killed them.
- **7** The king was enraged. He sent his army and destroyed those murderers and burned their city.
- **8** "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding banquet is ready, but those I invited did not deserve to come.
- **9** So go to the street corners and invite to the banquet anyone you find.'
- **10** So the servants went out into the streets and gathered all the people they could find, the bad as well

as the good, and the wedding hall was filled with guests.

**11** "But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing wedding clothes.

**12** He asked, 'How did you get in here without wedding clothes, friend?' The man was speechless.

**13** "Then the king told the attendants, 'Tie him hand and foot, and throw him outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' **14** "For many are invited, but few are chosen."
