The Word Became Flesh

- 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 2 He was with God in the beginning.
- 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.
- 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of men
- **5** The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.
- 6 There was a man who was sent from God his name was John.
- **7** He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe.
- 8 He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.
- **9** The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world.
- 10 He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him.

- 17 For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
- 18 No one has ever seen God, but God the One and Only, who is at the Father's side has made him known.
