

About EU branch of the Bali Nyonga Women's Group

"Nkumu Buwi Nyonga" is a nongovernmental, non-profit making Association of women from Bali Nyonga, a village situated in the Northwest Region of Cameroon. This Association was created in 2017 by Honourable Emma Yeluma Daiga.

The aims and purposes are:

1. To bring together mothers and grandmothers of Bali Nyonga origin who have fled from their homes because of the ongoing war in the Northwest and Southwest regions of Cameroon now known as the "Analophone Struagle".

These women are grouped on a WhatsApp Forum, where they can chat and exchange ideas with each other, to avoid isolation and loneliness in the various foreign countries to which they have fled.

- 2. To do charitable works such as:
 - helping orphans.
- providing food and shelter for those who have fled from their villages and are hiding in the bushes in and around Bali Nyonga.
- 3. Helping those in need of urgent medical assistance.
- 4. Assisting Cameroonian refugees in refugee camps in Nigeria.
- 5. Helping the poor and the needy in general.

Some of the funds to carry out all these aims are raised by the women themselves and some from well wishers and supporters. The Association has members from all over the world.
