Restore us, God Almighty; . . . that we may be saved. Psalm 80:7

'The pictures coming from a friend's text stream were stunning! Ripe for restoration! Such was the condition of God's people in Psalm 80 and thus the repeated prayer: "Restore us, O God; make your face shine on us, that we may be saved". Though their history had included rescue from Egypt and being planted in a land of plenty, the good times had come and gone. Because of rebellion, they were experiencing the hand of God's judgement. Thus, their plea: "Return to us, God Almighty! Look down from heaven and see!".

God? Is joyful soul-satisfaction missing? Is it because alignment with Jesus and His purposes is missing? God hears our prayers for restoration. What's keeping you from asking?
